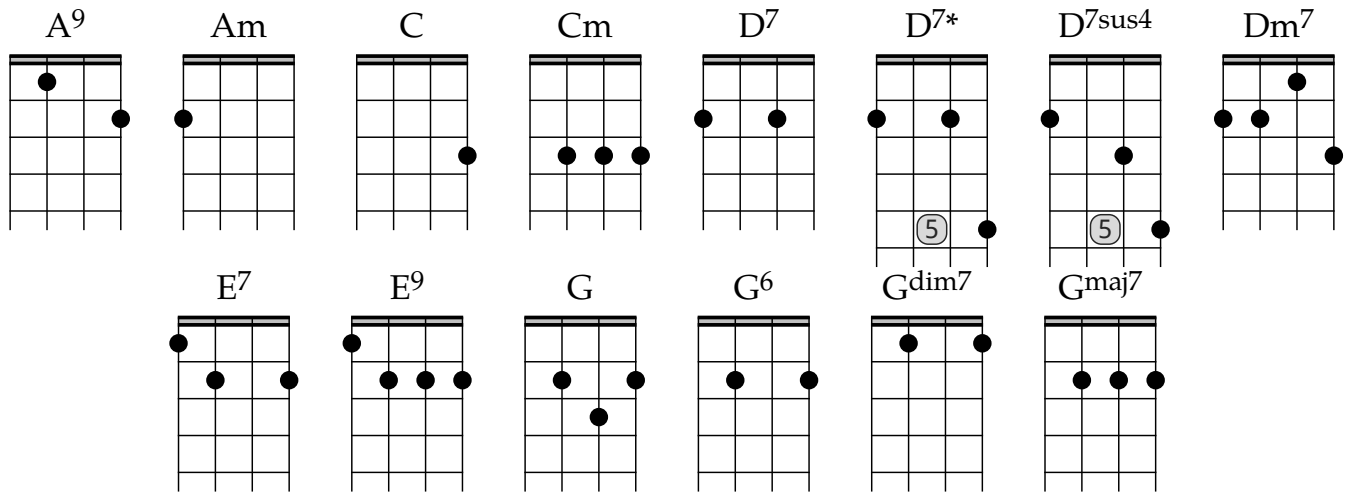


# Just a Gigolo - Casucci, Caesar / Graham, Williams

### Post-Verse

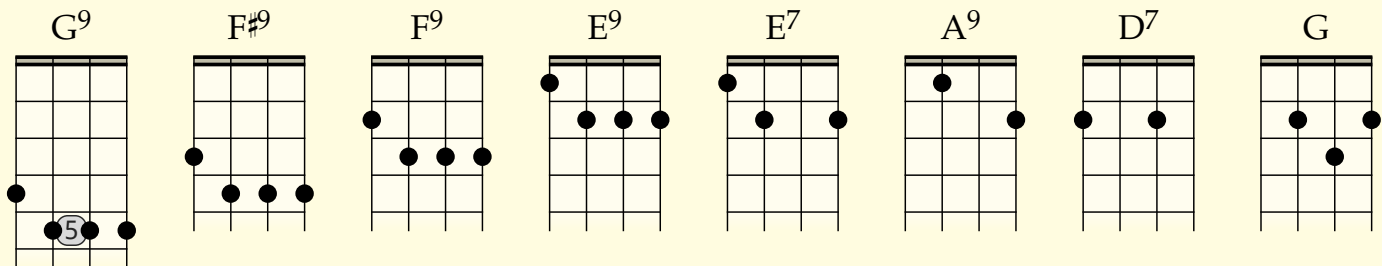
C When the end comes I know Cm
