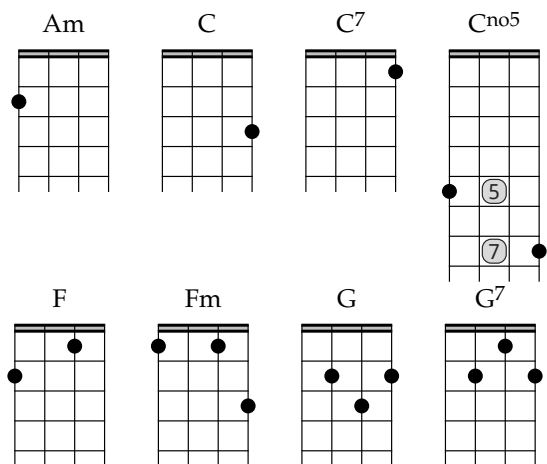


Silly Things - Ben Sures
