Running DOWN the C scale can be very fast with pull-offs, especially with the E and A strings getting 2 hammer-ons in a row!




Roll and Pull - Daniel Ward

Main repeated section (Ad nauseam)


Arpeggio pattern:

- Strum all four strings (4,3,2,1)
- Pull-off the A string
- Pick strings:
 - 2 (E-string)
 - 3 (C-string)
 - 4 (G-string)
 - 3 (C-string)
 - 2 (E-string)
 - 1 (A-string)
- On to the next strum!



Trickier ornamental bit Modified (shorter!) arpeggio pattern:

- Strum all four strings (4,3,2,1)
- Pull-off the A string
- Pick strings:
 - 2 (E-string)
 - 3 (C-string)
- On to the next strum!



At this point, you can either go back to the main loop, or wrap up with the outro: *Outro*


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



Hammer Pull Exercises

In order to keep your left hand around the G shape the whole time, this exercise uses a neat trick – fretting with the right hand! We need to hit the 7th fret of the A string (which would be quite a stretch from the G-chord shape), we can use our right-hand index finger to fret and then pick the string with our thumb.




Honing held hammers

This exercise uses lots of hammer and pulls to play notes quickly. It also holds a hammeron on the E string while playing a note on the A string, before coming back to pull-off the E string.
